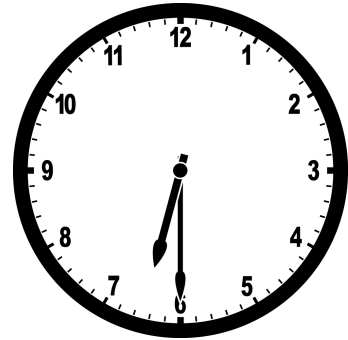

Theme 1: Living and Non-living Things

- Meaning of living and non-living things.
- Characteristics of living things: need food, grow, breathe, move, reproduce, respond to stimuli.
- Examples of living and non-living things from daily life.
- Differences between living and non-living things explained in simple language.

Theme 2: Human Body

- Major external body parts and their functions.
- Internal organs (heart, lungs, stomach, brain) – simple idea of their functions.
- Sense organs – eyes, ears, nose, tongue, skin and their uses.
- Importance of keeping the body healthy.
- Good habits: exercise, rest, healthy eating, cleanliness.

Theme 3: Birds

- Main body parts of a bird.
- Features of birds: wings, feathers, beaks, claws.
- Different types of beaks and claws with simple examples (e.g., sparrow, eagle, duck).
- How birds fly (in simple language).
- Nests of birds and how birds care for their young.
- Need to protect birds and their habitats.

Theme 4: Common Insects

- Identify common insects: ants, bees, butterflies, mosquitoes, flies.
- Body parts of insects: head, thorax, abdomen, antennae, wings.
- Helpful insects (bees, butterflies) and harmful insects (mosquitoes, houseflies).
- Importance of keeping surroundings clean to avoid insect-borne diseases.

Theme 5: Plants in the Surroundings

- Parts of a plant – root, stem, leaf, flower, fruit.
- Kinds of plants: trees, shrubs, herbs, climbers, creepers – with examples.
- Uses of plants: food, oxygen, shade, wood, medicine.
- Basic needs of plants: air, water, sunlight, soil.
- Care of plants and the importance of planting more trees.

Theme 6: Food We Get from Plants

- Different plant parts we eat: roots, stems, leaves, flowers, fruits, seeds—with examples.
- Sources of common foods: cereals, pulses, vegetables, fruits, oils.
- Importance of eating fresh fruits and vegetables.
- Simple idea of how food reaches us (farmer to market).

Theme 7: Cleanliness, Health and Hygiene

- Meaning of personal hygiene.
 - Healthy habits: bathing, brushing teeth, washing hands, cutting nails.
 - Clean surroundings and importance of waste disposal.
 - Drinking clean/safe water.
 - Basic rules to prevent common diseases.
 - Importance of vaccination and regular health check-ups.

Theme 8: Forms of Matter (Solids, Liquids and Gases)

- Meaning and examples of solids, liquids, and gases.
- Simple properties:
 - Solids have fixed shape.
 - Liquids take the shape of their container.

Theme 9: Some Properties of Water

- Water as a universal need.
- Properties: colourless, tasteless, odourless.
- Water dissolves many substances (simple explanation).
- Soluble and insoluble substances.
- Floating and sinking – simple idea with examples.
- Importance of clean water.

Theme 10: Water as a Resource

- Sources of water: rain, rivers, lakes, ponds, wells, taps.
- Uses of water in daily life.
- Importance of saving water.
- Ways to avoid wastage of water at home and school.
- Simple idea of water cycle (evaporation, condensation, rain).

Theme 11: Sun as a Natural Resource

- Sun as the main source of light and heat.
- Importance of sunlight for plants and animals.
- Day and night (simple idea).
- Safety rules while in the sun – avoid looking directly at the sun, using caps/umbrellas.
- Solar energy – very basic awareness.
